



## 2019 SKATE CANADA SYNCHRONIZED SKATING CHAMPIONSHIPS

### ENTRY QUOTA

#### SELECTION OF ENTRIES FROM REGIONALS

Selection of entries from Regional Synchronized Skating Championships to Synchronized Nationals Qualifying Rounds is as follows:

- a) The final result in each Regional event shall determine the competitors eligible to enter the equivalent National qualifying competition.
- b) **NOVICE, INTERMEDIATE, OPEN, JUNIOR AND SENIOR:** Teams that place first in Novice, Intermediate, Open, Junior and Senior categories at regional Qualifying Events qualify to the Canadian Synchronized Skating Championships
- c) **ADDITIONAL ENTRIES BASED ON REGISTERED ASSOCIATE MEMBERS IN SECTION:** For every 15,000 registered associate members in the Region, an additional team may be entered into each category at the National qualifying event. The number of sustaining members shall be determined by the membership year September 1 to August 31 of the year preceding the National qualifying event.
  - The following information represents the registration numbers per region for the membership year September 1 to August 31 of the year preceding the National qualifying event related to criteria c.

Mountain (BC/YT + AB/NT/NU):  $19846 + 26196 = 46042$

Prairie (SK + MB):  $7970 + 4391 = 12361$

Ontario (SO): = **71718**

Quebec (QC): **39850**

Atlantic (NB + NS + PEI + NL):  $3109 + 3119 + 1595 + 5103 = 12926$

d) Teams placing in the top five at the Skate Canada Synchronized Skating Championships will earn their Region an additional entry (or entries) into the respective category at the National qualifying round the following year.
