NCCP, Year In Review and Current– 2017/2018



NATIONAL COACH CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

- 2017 NCCP Season:
 - CanSkate Course – 13 courses total, 299 participants.
 - *New Regional Coach Course – 2 courses offered in total, 48 participants.
 - Provincial Coach Courses – all 6 courses were offered once in the new SO section (Sport Science, Stroking & Skating Skills, Singles, Dance, Pair & Synchro), 19 participants.
 - CanPowerSkate Course – 1 course offered, 8 participants.
- 2018 NCCP Season:
 - CanSkate Course – 13 courses offered.
 - Regional Coach Course – 9 courses offered.
 - Provincial Coach Courses – series of 6 courses being offered twice within the section.
 - *New CanPowerSkate Course – 2 courses offered.





Synchro Year In Review – 2017/2018



SYNCHRO

- Manager, Sport Development John Briscoe and Coordinator, Coaching Programs Stephanie Klein visited high performance teams across the province.
- First Skate Ontario Coaches Seminar took place in August 2017 in Oakville, ON. **67 coaches attended.**
- Skate Ontario provided Assess to Standard Training for coaches and officials via a webinar. **47 participants attended.**
- SYS Coach Enhancement Day offered to new/developing coaches at Winterfest. **18 coaches participated.**



What's New? – 2018/2019 Season



COACHES

- Respect In Sport Online Training Module (mandatory requirement to register as a coach for the new 18/19 season). Coaches must re-certify every 3 years. *Currently FREE and eligible for PD points!
- SO Coach Accreditation Tag – required for any coach attending an event in the province this year. Tags may be ordered online through the SO registration site.
- Skate Canada is compiling resources to help clarify ethical coaching behaviours and best practices as stated in the former Coaches Code of Ethics and will be releasing a new “Guide” in the coming months. Please keep an eye out for this on the Skate Canada Info Centre!

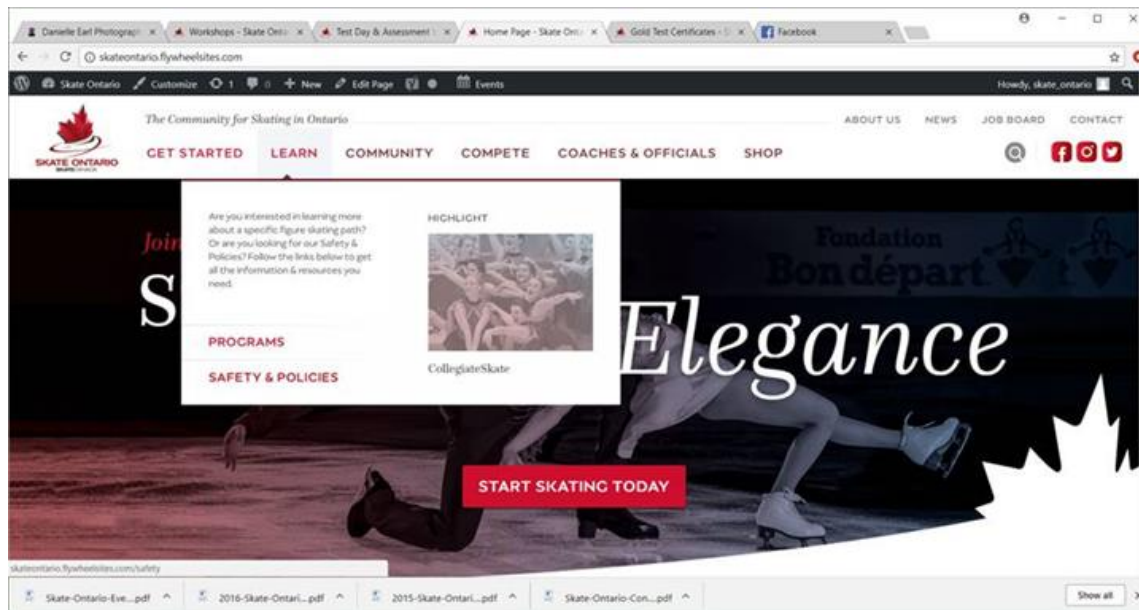

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- NCCP Coach Bursaries! ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?
 - 60% workshop only fee reimbursement
 - 70% workshop and evaluation fee combined reimbursement
 - 70% evaluation only fee reimbursement
 - Max \$300 fiscal year max
- Eligible in general:
 - Sport Specific other than Community Initiation/Ongoing NCCP context
 - Competition – Development Multi Sport Modules

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- Experts Express Bursary
 - 12 spots only
 - Club Coaches (no AAP carded athletes eg. nationally)
 - *Coaching Learn to Train and Learn to Compete stage athletes (STARSkate & Provincial Level)*
 - Access to Support Services funding for 4-12 hour program
 - Mental Training Expert
 - Sport Nutrition Expert
 - Strength and Conditioning Expert
 - Leadership and Management Expert
 - Coaching Athletes with a Disability
