An invitation is extended to all eligible figure skaters to participate in the 2019 Skate Ontario Sectionals Series – Paris Autumn Skate. Skate Canada rules and regulations will apply throughout the competition unless otherwise specified. Rule amendments passed at the Skate Canada Ice Summit as well as any changes to ISU regulations, applicable to Skate Canada sanctioned events shall also apply.

REGISTRATION:

Registration for this event is an **online submission** and must be completed in full, including payment. Registrants must also acknowledge and agree to all policies listed in the cart for the entry to be finalized.

Please have the following ready before registering:

- Skate Canada number (or USFSA number)
- category information
- partner's name, Skate Canada number, date of birth and home club (if applicable)
- coach's email
- credit card information

ONLINE MP3 MUSIC SUBMISSION:

For the Skate Ontario Sectional Series Events, competitors **have the option** to submit their music online or to submit CDs of their music on site at the competition. For the 2019-2020 season, online music upload submissions **will not** be required at the time of registration. Please refer to page 9 of this announcement for music details.

- Novice, Junior and Senior, all disciplines

These emails may include links to the competition entry lists, start orders and results as well as important athlete updates and practice ice information.



CLOSING DATE

Access to online registration will cease at **11:59 pm EST on July 28, 2019**. Registrations will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis with restrictions in certain categories to accommodate the scheduling of categories. Please review your entry information before submitting.

CONFIRMATION EMAILS

An email copy of each registration invoice will be automatically generated and sent to the account holder at the email address on the registrant's profile.

COACHES' CONFIRMATION EMAILS

Coaches will receive an email confirming their athlete's registration information (if the correct email is provided at registration). It is the responsibility of the registrant to ensure the accuracy of the coach(es) email.

CATEGORIES

All competitive categories (Singles, Pair and Ice Dance) will be combined categories only, with the exception of Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile Pattern and Free Dance which are offered as separate categories.

Starting orders shall be determined by a random draw in each category.

The following categories are to be held at the 2019 Skate Ontario Sectionals Series Paris Autumn Skate:

SENIOR

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. No age requirement.
Pair	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. No age requirement.
Ice Dance	Rhythm and Free Dance offered as a combined category only. At least one partner must have passed the following Gold Dance tests: Viennese Waltz & Argentine Tango No age requirement.



JUNIOR

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. Shall meet current ISU Junior age criteria - max. limit only applies.
Pair	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. No age requirement.
Ice Dance	Rhythm and Free Dance offered as a combined category only. At least one partner must have passed the following Gold Dance tests: Viennese Waltz & Argentine Tango Shall meet current ISU Junior age criteria - max. limit only applies.

NOVICE

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating test. Shall be under the age of 17 before July 1, 2019.
Pair	Must have passed the complete Senior Silver Free Skating test. No age requirements.
Ice Dance	Pattern and Free Dance offered as a combined category only. At least one partner must have passed the following dance tests: Killian, Rocker Foxtrot & Starlight Waltz Woman shall be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2019. Men shall be under the age of 21 before, July 1, 2019 Dances to be skated: Starlight Waltz & Quickstep

PRE-NOVICE

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate test. Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2019
Pair	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate test. Short and Free offered as a combined category only. Shall be under the age of 18 before July 1, 2019
Ice Dance	Pattern and Free Dance offered as a combined category only At least one partner must have passed the complete STAR 5 Dance test or higher Shall be under the age of 18 before July 1, 2019 Dances to be skated: Starlight Waltz & Paso Doble



JUVENILE

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate test or higher.
Women/Men (U12)	Shall be under the age of 12 before July 1, 2019
Women/Men (U14)	Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2019
Pair	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate test or higher. Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2019
Ice Dance	At least one partner must have passed the complete STAR 5 Dance test or higher. Pattern and Free Dance offered as separate categories. Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2019 Dances to be skated: Willow Waltz & Foxtrot

PRE-JUVENILE

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate test or higher.
Women/Men (U11)	Shall be under the age of 11 before July 1, 2019
Women/Men (U13)	Shall be under the age of 13 before July 1, 2019
Pair	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate test or higher. Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2019
Ice Dance	At least one partner must have passed the complete STAR 5 Dance test or higher. Pattern & Free Dance offered as separate categories. Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2019 Dances to be skated: Fiesta Tango & Willow Waltz

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration is finalized only when all information is filled in and payment completed. Your receipt of payment is your registration confirmation. Please print your receipt and retain for your records.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries received after the closing date will be considered by the Technical Representative for registration. Late entries are subject to a late fee of a 50% surcharge of registration fees for all categories. No late entries will be considered after start orders are posted (two weeks before event start).

REFUNDS: Full refunds will be given for any cancelled categories.

MEDICAL REFUNDS: Medical refunds will be granted at 50% of registration fees until the commencement of the competition on September 27, 2019. All medical requests must be sent to Lauren Zbucki a lzbucki@skateontario.org. The request **MUST** be received before the first skate of the day on September 27, 2019 **and MUST** be accompanied by a signed physician's note. Notes from non-medical care providers such as physiotherapists, chiropractors or athletic therapists are NOT acceptable. A new physician's note will be required for each competition. NOTE: Athletes who receive a medical refund must withdraw from the entire competition. Therefore, an athlete may not receive a medical refund for one category but compete in another category at the same event.

WITHDRAWALS PRIOR TO REGISTRATION CLOSE: If an entry is withdrawn prior to July 28, 2019, a refund (less an administrative fee of \$50.00 per skater) shall be granted.

CHANGE OF CATEGORY FEE: There will be a \$50 change of category fee applied for each granted change request after an online registration has been submitted.

RESTRICTIONS: Athletes cannot register in two categories of the same discipline. For example: registering both in Juvenile Free Skate and Pre-Novice Singles will not be allowed. Athletes may register for two different disciplines such as Novice Singles and Novice Ice Dance.

CATEGORIES: In the case of a very large entry in any category, the entries will be drawn into groups. In the case of very small entries into a category divided by age, Skate Ontario may elect to combine age categories.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: As of July 1, 2019.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION: All competitors and Skate Canada registered coaches are required to register upon arrival at the arena. Registration and music registration will commence one hour prior to the first category of the day. Each competitor will receive an accreditation tag that must be retained and used as a pass for the duration of the competition. All skaters **MUST** have their music CDs and planned program content sheet when registering. Coaches must provide proof that they are a registered Skate Canada professional coach in good standing.

COACH ACCREDITATION: To be accredited at the 2019 Skate Ontario Sectionals Series Paris Autumn Skate, coaches must be Primary STARSkate trained or certified. Ontario coaches must present their Skate Ontario issued coach accreditation tag. No other form of identification will be accepted. Out of province coaches must provide proof that they are a registered Skate Canada professional coach in good standing when registering at the coaches' sign in table. Up to two certified coaches per entry will be accredited.



MUSIC

ONLINE MP3 MUSIC SUBMISSION:

For the Skate Ontario Sectional Series Events, competitors **have the option** to submit their music online or to submit CDs of their music on site at the competition. For the 2019-2020 season, online music upload submissions **will not** be required at the time of registration.

The music upload window for Sectionals Series #3 – Paris Autumn Skate will open on Monday, July 22 & 23, 2019 at 6:00 PM with registration and will close for updating on Sunday, September 1st, 2019 at 11:59 pm EST. An email with how to update online music submission instructions will be sent to registered athletes by Monday, July 29th, 2019. To upload and change music, athletes will be required to login to their Uplifter registration account.

Online music submissions will not be accepted after August 18th. Any competitor who does not submit their music online by August 18th must bring their music on CD to the competition venue and submit it on site at registration.

Competitors who submit music online are still required to register 2 CD copies of their music at the competition as backup.

Competitors are reminded to ensure that the music that is uploaded is the correct version for the 2019-20 season.

Pre-Novice and Novice Dance competitors: Pre-Novice and Novice Dance competitors are required to submit pattern dance music whether they are skating to contemporary music or to ISU pattern dance music.

The only file format which can be accepted online is MP3. The start of the music shall be recorded with less than two seconds of lead in.

Online music files will not be kept after a competition is complete. Competitors are required to upload their music for each individual competition. (Example; music will not be kept from Sectionals Series #1 to Sectionals Series #3). This will reduce the chance of the wrong music being played.

GENERAL MUSIC REQUIREMENTS – INSTRUCTIONS: ALL SKATERS competing in the Sectional **CDs:** Each entry must also provide two CDs of the correct music for the competition upon registration, one for competition - marked “Master” and one for back up - marked “Copy”. These must be registered with music registration at least one hour prior to the posted start time of the category and may not be removed for any reason until after the category is completed. CD audio discs are the only music format accepted. iPhones, iPods or other digital sources will not be accepted as backups. Music must be picked up within 30 minutes after completion of the category.

All music used must be in the public domain or covered by performing rights societies. Competitors who have music composed specifically for their programs either wholly or in part, are responsible for obtaining a written release from the composer for the use of such music on radio and/or television or appropriate clearance from performing rights societies.



Standard Specifications for music:

- (1) Only one program shall be recorded on each CD
- (2) Competitor's name followed by home club, category, program type-short or free and music time shall be printed on front of the CD label using a black Sharpie pen
- (3) Each CD shall be enclosed in a plastic case in good repair marked with the skater's name, home club, category, program type – short or free, and total music time

Technical Guidelines for music CDs:

- (1) Music on CD must be burned in CD audio format (NOT mp3; .acc or DVD)
- (2) Music should be burned on CD-R discs of good quality that provide legible space for skater information to be printed on
- (3) It is recommended that CDs be burned at speeds 16Xs or less
- (4) The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in
- (5) Skaters or teams should keep a set of CDs for COMPETITION USE ONLY. It is recommended that this set be used for each competition unless the music has been changed

AWARDS

Medals for first, second and third place will be awarded for each category. Medal presentation information will be available at the competition.
