




## Skate Ontario Registration Process Update – June 18, 2019

In consultation with coaches and work with Uplifter, Skate Ontario has created a new event registration procedure to address the shortcomings of the previous registration process.

For the 2019/20 season, Super, STAR 1 - 4 and Synchro Series event registration will begin with a 'Coach Pre-Registration' where coaches will be asked to indicate the number of athletes they have in various category groupings and rank the top-five events they want their skaters to participate in.

After gathering information from the Coach Pre-Registration and looking at the data from a big picture point-of-view, the objective of the new registration process is to ensure athletes get into the competitions they want.


The result of completing the Coach Pre-Registration process is that all coaches' athletes will be able to compete at one event. This will decrease costs for athletes and reduce travel time for coaches.
