Registration for this event is an online submission and must be completed in full, including payment. Registrants must also acknowledge and agree to all policies listed in the cart for the entry to be finalized.

Registration will open at noon on February 28, 2020 and close at 11:59 pm EST on Friday, March 6, 2020 for categories that are below the maximum number of entries as per the Super Series announcement (refer to pages 2-3 of this announcement). These athletes will receive an email with a link to complete registration. The link to the registration portal will be sent to you on February 27th.

Failure to register by the deadline of 11:59 pm EST on March 6th indicates that you have chosen not to participate. No late entries will be accepted.

Skaters are only considered as being registered once the registration form is complete and payment is made.

Registration will open for all other categories will open at noon EST on Wednesday, March 11, 2020 and close at 11:59 EST pm on Sunday, March 15, 2020. These athletes will receive an email with a link to complete registration.

Failure to register by the deadline of 11:59 pm EST on March 15th indicates that you have chosen not to participate, and the spot will go to the next highest placed skater.

Skaters are only considered as being registered once the registration form is complete and payment is made.

An email copy of each registration invoice will be automatically generated and sent to the account holder at the email address on the registrant's profile.

Please note that if you select “no” for News, Upcoming Program and Registration Information in the Message List on your Uplifter Registration account, you will not receive general emails from Skate Ontario about the event. These emails may include links to the competition entry lists, start orders and results as well as important athlete updates.



2020 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships Super Series Qualifying Structure:

For the 2019/20 season, Skate Ontario is using a qualifying structure (the Super Series) for entry into the Provincial Championships being held in March of 2020. This series is for athletes competing in STAR 5, STAR 6, STAR 7, STAR 8, STAR 9, STAR 10, Gold, Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile, Pre-Novice, Novice, Junior and Senior in the men, women, pair, and ice dance categories. Final participant numbers for each category qualifying for the Provincial Championships are noted below.

Athletes will qualify for the 2020 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships using the following criteria:

1. Skate Ontario will be offering Super Series events throughout the province of Ontario between October 25, 2019 and March 8, 2020. Athletes must register for the Super Series with Skate Ontario for their Super Series scores to be tracked and listed in the ranking order. Registration will be available on the Skate Ontario website on or before October 1, 2019 and will close at 3:00 pm ET on Monday, December 16, 2019.
2. All Super Series events will have a base event package that will include STAR 5, STAR 6, STAR 7, STAR 8, STAR 9, STAR 10, Gold, Pre-Juvenile and Juvenile categories in men and women.
3. The best Super Series score from each athlete or team will be used in the final ranking order for qualification into the 2020 Provincial Championships.
4. Only Skate Ontario Super Series scores will qualify for a ranking position.
5. There are no maximum number of Super Series events an athlete can enter. The best Super Series score will be used in the ranking order.
6. Pre-Novice, Novice, Junior and Senior categories will be free program only events.
7. Skaters who are not Canadian citizens are eligible to qualify for the 2020 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships, provided the following criteria is met:
 - a. The skater(s) is/are registered with a Skate Canada member club or skating school in Ontario.
 - b. The skater(s) is/are not representing another country at a qualifying event (e.g. Regionals/Sectionals).
 - c. All test qualifications for the Skate Ontario Super Series event(s) entered are met

COACHES' CONFIRMATION EMAILS:

Coaches will receive an email confirming their athlete's registration information if the correct email is provided at registration. It is the responsibility of the registrant to ensure the accuracy of the coach(es) email.

COACH ACCREDITATION:

To be accredited at the 2020 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships, coaches must be Primary STARSkate trained or certified. Ontario coaches must present their Skate Ontario issued Coach's Accreditation Tag. **No other form of identification will be accepted.** Out of province coaches must provide proof that they are a Registered Skate Canada Professional Coach in Good Standing when registering at the Coaches' sign in table. Up to two certified coaches per entry will be accredited

CATEGORIES:

Starting Orders shall be determined by a random draw in each category.

Pair	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2019
Ice Dance	At least one partner must have passed the complete STAR 5 Dance assessment or higher. Pattern & Free Dance offered as a combined category only. Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2019

JUVENILE

Women/Men (U12)	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 12 before July 1, 2019
Women/Men (U14)	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2019
Pair	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2019
Ice Dance	At least one partner must have passed the complete STAR 5 Dance assessment or higher. Pattern and Free Dance offered as a combined category only. Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2019

Women/Men	Free Skate Only. Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate assessment. Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2019
Pair	Free Skate Only. Must have passed the complete STAR 5 Free Skate assessment. Shall be under the age of 18 before July 1, 2019
Ice Dance	Free Dance offered only At least one partner must have passed the complete STAR 5 Dance assessment or higher Shall be under the age of 18 before July 1, 2019

NOVICE

Women/Men	Free Skate Only. Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating assessment. Shall be under the age of 17 before July 1, 2019.
Pair	Free Skate Only. Must have passed the complete STAR 10 assessment. No age requirements.
Ice Dance	Free Dance offered only. At least one partner must have passed the following dance assessment: Killian, Rocker Foxtrot & Starlight Waltz Woman shall be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2019. Men shall be under the age of 21 before, July 1, 2019

Women/Men	Free Skate Only. Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating assessment. Shall meet current ISU Junior age criteria - max. limit only applies.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration is finalized only when all information and payment is complete. Your receipt of payment is your registration confirmation. Please print your receipt and retain for your records.

REFUNDS: Full refunds will be given for any cancelled categories.

MEDICAL REFUNDS: Medical refunds will be granted at 50% of registration fees until the commencement of the competition on March 26, 2020. All medical requests must be sent to Michelle Hunsley mhunsley@skateontario.org. This request **MUST** be received before the first skate of the day on March 26, 2020 and **MUST** be accompanied by a signed medical physician's (MD) note. Notes from non-medical care providers such as physiotherapists, chiropractors or athletic therapists are NOT acceptable. A new physician's note will be required for each competition – notes from previous competitions will not be honoured. NOTE: Athletes who receive a medical refund must withdraw from the entire competition. Therefore, an athlete may not receive a medical refund for one category but compete in another category at the same event.

WITHDRAWALS PRIOR TO REGISTRATION CLOSE: If an entry is withdrawn prior to March 6, 2020 (for categories below the maximum number of entries) and March 15, 2020 for all other categories, a refund (less an administrative fee of \$50.00) will be granted.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: As on July 1, 2019.

TEST REQUIREMENTS: As on November 15, 2019.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION: All competitors and Skate Canada registered coaches are required to register upon arrival at the arena. Registration and music registration will commence one hour prior to the first category of the day. All skaters **MUST** have their music and planned program content sheet (if applicable) when registering.

AWARDS: Medals for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place will be awarded for each category, including categories which are divided into A & B or A, B & C. Medal presentation information will be available at the competition.

GENERAL MUSIC REQUIREMENTS - INSTRUCTIONS

CDs: Each entry must provide two CDs of the correct music for the competition upon registration, one for competition - marked "Master" and one for back up - marked "Copy". These must be registered with music registration at least one hour prior to the posted start time of the category and may not be removed for any reason until after the category is completed. CD Audio Discs are the only music format accepted. iPhones, iPods or other digital sources will not be accepted as backups. Music must be picked up within 30 minutes after completion of the category.

Pattern Dance Music: All athletes are required to submit their pattern dance music at music registration.

All music used must be in the public domain or covered by the performing rights societies. Competitors who have music composed specifically for their programs either wholly or in part, are responsible for obtaining a written release from the composer for the use of such music on radio and/or television or appropriate clearance from the performing rights societies

Standard Specifications for Music:

- (1) Only one program shall be recorded on each CD
- (2) Competitor's name followed by home club, category, program type-short or free and music time shall be printed on front of the CD label using a black Sharpie pen
- (3) Each CD shall be enclosed in a plastic case in good repair marked with the skater's



name, home club, category, program type – short or free, and total music time

Technical Guidelines for Music CDs:

- (1) Music on CD must be burned in CD Audio Format (NOT mp3; .acc or DVD)
- (2) Music should be burned on CD-R discs of good quality that provide legible space for the skater information to be printed on
- (3) It is recommended that CDs be burned at speeds 16Xs or less
- (4) The start of the music shall be recorded on the CD with less than two seconds of lead in
