

COACH/PARENT PLANNING - EFFECTIVE MEETING STRUCTURE

This document presents a structure for conducting coach/parent meetings. Based on strategic meeting models, this structure can be adapted to suit skaters at a variety of levels and stages.

1	CELEBRATE SUCCESSES and LEARN FROM SET BACKS	Review successes from the previous season
2	LOOK AHEAD TO NEXT SEASON	Establish the skater's • level of committment
3	STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS	Consider • identifying periods of transition throughout the season • building Performance and Development Opportunities into the plan • communicating during the year - establish "check-ins" throughout the season in order to stay on track Analyze the common factors that create successes or cause set backs • implement the concept of the school year
4	VALUES	Establish common values for coach/skater/parent like • positive attitude • work ethic • respect for others
