



Modified Stage 2 Assessment Days

Assessment Days continue in Modified Stage 2 regions that are able to proceed within the regulations laid out in [Ontario Regulation 572/20](#), Schedule 2, Section 13 and Skate Ontario Return To Play Protocols 4.2. The regulation applies to all indoor sports and recreational facilities including community centres, multi-purpose facilities and arenas in Toronto, Peel, York and Ottawa.

The total number of members of the public permitted to be in a class, organized program or organized activity at the facility cannot exceed 10 people and each class, organized program or organized activity must take place in a separate room.

Assessment Coordinators in these areas will connect with you directly on changes to their scheduled Assessment Days. Should you not feel comfortable assessing at this time and you are scheduled for an Assessment Day, please let your Assessment Coordinator and [Dia Sue-Wah-Sing, Coordinator, Officials](#) know immediately. We look forward to connecting you with opportunities when you are ready.

For areas outside of those with enhanced measures regions, the training group sizes referenced in Skate Ontario Return to Play Protocols 4.2 (October 2, 2020) will continue to apply.

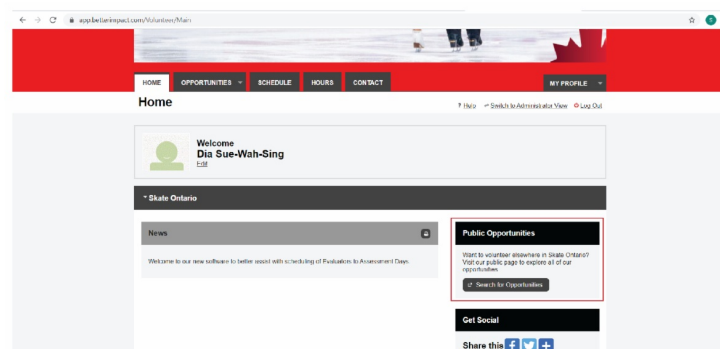

Better Impact- Digital Tool for Assessment Days

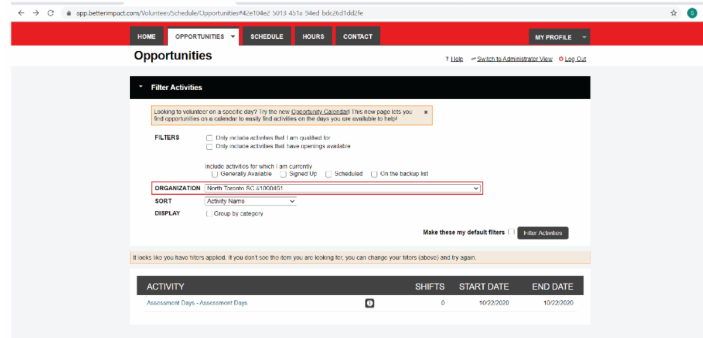

New Assessment Days are added daily, please check the public listings in your dashboard. Notifications are not automatic at this time.

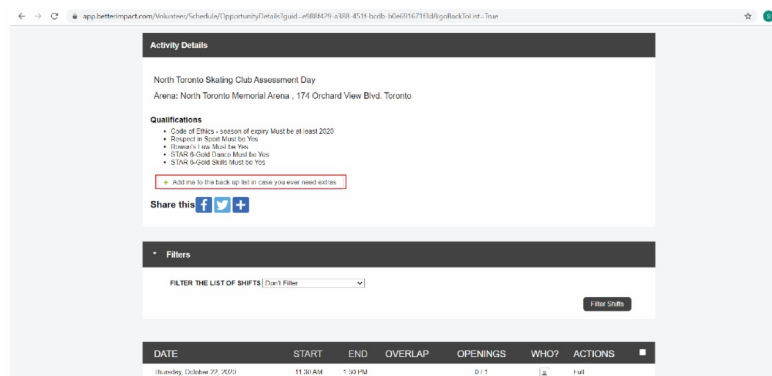
