Skate Ontario is excited to announce a video submission-based performance opportunity for skaters as we begin to return to skating events in Ontario; **Skate ON - Video Performance Series**.

Skaters will follow filming requirements and submit a video to Skate Ontario by the posted deadline. Individual report cards will be produced by Data Specialists. Skaters will not be ranked. This is not a performance on demand performance opportunity. Skaters are asked to practice social distancing while filming their program.

An invitation is extended to all skaters to participate in the Skate ON Virtual Event #5. Skate Canada rules and regulations will apply throughout the competition unless otherwise specified.

## **REGISTRATION:**

Registration for this event is an **online registration and video submission** and must be completed in full, including payment and video upload. Registrants must also acknowledge and agree to all policies listed in the cart for the entry to be finalized.

Women/Men	Shall be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2020
<b>STAR 7 Singles</b>	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate a assessment
Women/Men (U12)	Shall be under the age of 12 before July 1, 2020
Women/Men (O12)	Shall be 12 years or over and under the age of 19 before July 1, 2020
<b>STAR 8 Singles</b>	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment
Women/Men	Shall be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2020
<b>STAR 9 Singles</b>	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment
Women/Men (U14)	Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2020
Women/Men (O14)	Shall be 14 years or over and under the age of 19 before July 1, 2020
<b>STAR 10 Singles</b>	Must have passed the complete STAR 8 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment
Women/Men	Shall be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2020
<b>Gold Singles</b>	Must have passed the complete STAR 8 Free Skate assessment
Women/Men	No age requirement

Women/Men (U11)	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 11 before July 1, 2020
Women/Men (U13)	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 13 before July 1, 2020
<b>Juvenile</b>	
Women/Men (U12)	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 12 before July 1, 2020
Women/Men (U14)	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2020



### PRE-NOVICE

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment. Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2020 Short and Free Skate offered as separate categories only
Pair	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment. Shall be under the age of 18 before July 1, 2020 Short and Free programs offered as separate categories only.
Ice Dance	At least one partner must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Dance assessment or higher Shall be under the age of 18 before July 1, 2020 Pattern and Free Dance offered as separate categories only  Pattern Dances to be skated: <b>Tango</b> (2 sequences) & <b>Blues</b> (3 sequences)

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating assessment. Shall be under the age of 17 before July 1, 2020 Short and Free Skate offered as separate categories only
Pair	Must have passed the complete STAR 10 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment. No age requirements Short and Free programs offered as separate categories only.
Ice Dance	At least one partner must have passed the following dance assessment: Killian, Rocker Foxtrot & Starlight Waltz Woman shall be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2020. Men shall be under the age of 21 before, July 1, 2020 Pattern and Free Dance offered as separate categories only  Pattern Dances to be skated: <b>Blues</b> (3 sequences) & <b>Westminster Waltz</b> (2 Sequences each with 2 sections steps 1-12 & 13-22)



## **JUNIOR**

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating assessment. Shall be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2020 Short and Free programs offered as separate categories only.
Pair	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating assessment. No age requirement. Short and Free programs offered as separate categories only.
Ice Dance	At least one partner must have passed the Gold A and Gold B Dance assessments or higher Rhythm and Free programs offered as separate categories only.  Shall meet current ISU Junior age criteria (maximum age limit only applies) <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Women must be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2020</li><li>• Men must be under the age of 21 before July 1, 2020</li></ul>

## **SENIOR**

Women/Men	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating assessment. No age requirement. Short and Free programs offered as separate categories only.
Pair	Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating assessment. No age requirement. Short and Free programs offered as separate categories only.
Ice Dance	At least one partner must have passed Gold A and Gold B Dance assessments or higher No age requirement. Rhythm and Free programs offered as separate categories only.

## **ARTISTIC - No age requirement**

STAR 5	May have passed STAR 4 Skills Assessment or Introductory Interpretive test
STAR 7	May have passed STAR 5 Artistic assessment or Bronze Interpretive test or higher
STAR 9	May have passed STAR 7 Artistic assessment or Silver Interpretive test but no higher
Gold	May have passed Gold Artistic assessment or Gold Interpretive test

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration is finalized only when both online registration and video submission is completed, and payment completed. Your receipt of payment is your registration confirmation. Please print your receipt and retain for your records.

**LATE ENTRIES:** Late entries will not be considered.

**REFUNDS:** NO REFUNDS (including medical) will be given after registration close.

**WITHDRAWALS PRIOR TO REGISTRATION CLOSE:** If an entry is withdrawn prior to the registration closing date, a refund (less an administrative fee of \$25.00 per skater/team) will be granted.

**AGE REQUIREMENTS:** As of July 1, 2020.

**TEST REQUIREMENTS:** As of February 15, 2021

## FILMING REQUIREMENTS

- Programs can be film with a phone, tablet and/or camera
  - All programs must be filmed in high resolution. Formats accepted include Mov, .MP4 File WebM, MJPEG, MPEGPS, WMV, FLV, MTS, OGG
- Other skaters and coaches can be on the ice when the program is being filmed, a skater is not required to have private or clear ice.
- We recommend music to be turned up high when the program is being filmed. We want to ensure the music is loud enough for the officials to hear when they watch the videos during the judging process.
- Skaters can wear their competition attire or proper practice attire. (Note: No distracting material)
- Filming must take place at ice level, as close to centre ice as possible. It is important that when filming, all corners of the ice can be captured.
- Video submissions must be filmed from a judge's angle. (Skater to perform to the camera)
- Please ensure the athlete's full body is always visible during their skating performance, including and most importantly, the position of their skate blade.
- Please test the filming set up (ie phone, tablet/or camera) prior to performance, to ensure video quality.
- Please film in either landscape or portrait mode for the duration of the program, ensuring the athlete's full body is in the video. Example: Please do not change from portrait to landscape during the program, or vice versa.

### Important to note:

- You will not be judged or scored based on the quality or location of video.



## VIDEO SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- **Before submitting video, please name your video file with your athlete's full name and their category. FOR EXAMPLE: JOHN\_SMITH\_STAR5U10\_MEN\_FR.MOV**
- If your video file size is too large to upload, please reach out to [events@skateontario.org](mailto:events@skateontario.org)
- Upload the original video recorded (example a video that has been texted will have lower quality)
- Video submissions must not contain any editing
