

Skate Ontario Super Series & Provincial Championships 2021/22 Season

The Skate Ontario Super Series is an opportunity for Ontario skaters to compete throughout the winter skating season. Athletes compete in STAR 5, STAR 6, STAR 7, STAR 8, STAR 9, STAR 10, Gold, Pre-Juvenile, Juvenile, Pre-Novice, Novice, Junior and Senior in the men, women, pair, artistic and ice dance categories at Skate Ontario Super Series events and have the opportunity to qualify for entry into the Provincial Championships being held in March of 2022.

This season, as we return to skating following COVID-19, we have important NEW information to share with you, regarding the Skate Ontario Super Series.

1. **ALL skaters who intend to compete in a Super Series event this season must complete the [Super Series Registration](#).** Within this survey, skaters can indicate if they would like their score tracked for the purpose of qualifying for the Skate Ontario Provincial Championships.

Registration for the Super Series will begin at 12:00 pm ET on October 22, 2021, and will close at 3:00 pm ET on Wednesday, December 15, 2021.

2. **In the 2021-22 season, skaters may enter a maximum of 2 Super Series events between January 1 and March 6.** This restriction is being put in place, so we can provide competitive opportunities to as many skaters as possible during this season of returning to events following COVID-19.
3. **Advance Registration – GTA events:**

To facilitate registration for the January & February events in the GTA, we will give skaters whose home club is in the GTA and surrounding areas, the option for advance registration into one GTA event each month.

January – Choose 1: Grimsby (January 7-9) **or** Milton (January 21-23)

February – Choose 1: GTA competition (February 11-13) **or** Georgina (February 25-27)

The intent is to provide an opportunity for skaters in the GTA & Surrounding areas to compete in one of these competitions each month if they so choose. Skaters will be asked to select their first choice & second choice for events each month. Please note, we will do our best to accommodate as many first choices as possible, but we ask for your understanding if this is not possible for all skaters.

The deadline for providing your advance registration options is Monday November 1, 2021, at 9:00 am ET.

Please note, registration links will be provided by November 8, 2021, for the January events. Once your link is provided, you will have a window of several days to complete your event registration at your leisure.

2022 Skate Ontario Qualifying Structure Provincial Championships 2021/22 Season

Athletes competing in the Skate Ontario Super Series, to qualify for the 2022 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships please note the following:

1. **Skaters must register for the Super Series by 3:00 pm ET on Wednesday, December 15, 2021, and select for their score to be tracked.**

➤ **Super Series Registration**

2. A separate registration should be completed for each event in which the skater intends to compete.
3. The highest Super Series score from each athlete or team will be used in the final ranking order for qualification into the 2022 Provincial Championships.
4. Only Skate Ontario Super Series scores can be used to determine a ranking position.
5. Pre-Novice, Novice, Junior, and Senior categories will be free program only events.
6. Skaters who are not Canadian citizens are eligible to qualify for the 2022 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships, provided the following criteria is met:
 - a. The skater(s) is/are registered with a Skate Canada member club or skating school in Ontario.
 - b. The skater(s) is/are not representing another country at a qualifying event (e.g., Regionals/Sectionals).
 - c. All test qualifications for the Skate Ontario Super Series event(s) entered are met.
7. Estimated Maximum Entry Numbers for the 2022 Provincial Championships can be found below.

Please note that Skate Ontario reserves the right to adjust the number of entries based on the evolution of the 2021/22 season and to comply with capacity limits at the competition venue for the 2022 Provincial Championships.

The final Maximum Entry Numbers will be communicated on or before February 10, 2022.

8. For each category, the posted interim ranking list will only show scores for the maximum number of entries at the 2022 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships.
9. Skate Ontario reserves the right to alter the Provincial Qualifying Structure based on the evolving COVID-19 pandemic.
