. REGISTRATION:

Registration for this event is an **online registration and video submission** and must be completed in full, including payment and video upload. Registrants must also acknowledge and agree to all policies listed in the cart for the entry to be finalized.

Registrants will be required to attest that their submission was filmed once and was unedited before registration may be completed.

REGISTRATION OPENING & CLOSING DATES:

Registration for this event will open at 12:00 pm noon EST on January 17, 2022, and will close at 11:59 pm EST on February 6, 2022.

Videos will be officiated remotely from February 18-20, 2022, and results will be posted online

CONFIRMATION EMAILS

Women/Men	Shall be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2021
STAR 7 Singles	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate a assessment
Women/Men (U12)	Shall be under the age of 12 before July 1, 2021
Women/Men (O12)	Shall be 12 years or over and under the age of 19 before July 1, 2021
STAR 8 Singles	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment

STAR 9 Singles	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment
Women/Men (U14)	Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2021
Women/Men (O14)	Shall be 14 years or over before July 1, 2021
STAR 10 Singles	Must have passed the complete STAR 8 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment
Women/Men	Shall be under the age of 19 before July 1, 2021
Gold Singles	Must have passed the complete STAR 8 Free Skate assessment
Women/Men	No age requirement

Women/Men (U11)	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 11 before July 1, 2021
Women/Men (U13)	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 13 before July 1, 2021
Juvenile	
Women/Men (U12)	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 12 before July 1, 2021
Women/Men (U14)	Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment or higher. Shall be under the age of 14 before July 1, 2021

Women/Men Must have passed the complete STAR 5 (or equivalent) Free Skate assessment.
 Shall be under the age of 16 before July 1, 2021

NOVICE

Women/Men Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating assessment.
 Shall be under the age of 17 before July 1, 2021

JUNIOR

Women/Men Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating assessment.
 Shall meet current ISU Junior age criteria - max. limit only applies.

SENIOR

Women/Men Must have passed the complete Gold Free Skating assessment.
 No age requirement.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration is finalized only when both online registration and video submission is completed, and payment completed. Your receipt of payment is your registration confirmation. Please print your receipt and retain for your records.

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries will not be considered.

WITHDRAWALS PRIOR TO REGISTRATION CLOSE: If an entry is withdrawn prior to the registration closing date, a refund (less an administrative fee of \$10.00 per skater/team) will be granted



FILMING REQUIREMENTS

- Programs can be film with a phone, tablet and/or camera
 - All programs must be filmed in high resolution. Formats accepted include Mov, .MP4 File WebM, MJPEG, MPEGPS, WMV, FLV, MTS, OGG
- Other skaters and coaches can be on the ice when the program is being filmed, a skater is not required to have private or clear ice.
- We recommend music to be turned up high when the program is being filmed. We want to ensure the music is loud enough for the officials to hear when they watch the videos during the judging process.
- Skaters can wear their competition attire or proper practice attire. (Note: No distracting material)
- Filming must take place at ice level, as close to centre ice as possible. It is important that when filming, all corners of the ice can be captured.
- Video submissions must be filmed from a judge's angle. (Skater to perform to the camera)
- Please ensure the athlete's full body is always visible during their skating performance, including and most importantly, the position of their skate blade.
- Please test the filming set up (ie phone, tablet/or camera) prior to performance, to ensure video quality.
- Please film in either landscape or portrait mode for the duration of the program, ensuring the athlete's full body is in the video. Example: Please do not change from portrait to landscape during the program, or vice versa.
- You will not be judged or scored based on the quality or location of video.

Video Submission Requirements

- Before submitting video, please name your video file with your athlete's full name and their category. FOR EXAMPLE: **JOHN_SMITH_STAR5U10_MEN_FR.MOV**

The proper naming of your video is extremely important. This allows for videos to be placed in the proper category files for judging.

If your video file size is too large to upload, please reach out to events@skateontario.org

- Upload the original video recorded (example a video that has been texted will have lower quality)
- Video submissions must not contain any editing
