

## Coach in "Good Standing" and NCCP Certification Status

## "Good standing" status

Clubs can access "Good Standing" status on the Skate Canada Members site. Once signed in, the information can be found under the Coach Eligibility tab. Enter the name of the coach in the search tool. Pick their name from the list to see "Good Standing" status.

A "Yes" answer will indicate that on today's date all the matrix items (outlined in the Good Standing matrix chart) are valid.

A "No" response will indicate that one or more of the matrix items are not valid. If this is the case, the coach is not eligible to coach in any capacity until their coach dashboard has been updated and reads in "good standing". It is the responsibility of the contracted coach to ensure their coach dashboard remains up to date and valid throughout the duration of the contracted skating season.

## NCCP Certification

Anyone can check a coach's NCCP level and Maintenance of Certification through the Coaching Association of Canada's (CAC) website. The CAC "Locker" will show their current NCCP and Maintenance of Certification status.

## Note:

If the required point total associated with a coach's Maintenance of Certification cycle has not been met, their NCCP status will read "not active" and the coach is not eligible to be coach in any capacity in a Skate Canada club until resolved.

To check NCCP level, visit <u>The Locker</u>. You will need the coaches last name and their NCCP number. (The NCCP number is listed on the Coach Eligibility tab on the Skate Canada Members site.)

The site will show the coaches public transcript which includes current certification, certification maintenance (professional development points), and any recent training.
