



Skate Ontario Coach Assessor Pathway

Skate Canada coaches may now become qualified as a Skills Coach Assessor for STAR 6-Gold. This document outlines the steps required for Ontario coaches to become qualified as a Skills Coach Assessor.

Prerequisites: NCCP Regional Coach In-Training or higher status
Qualified as a STAR 1-5 Coach Assessor
Completion of STAR 6-Gold Skills e-learning course

There are 5 steps that need to be completed before conducting your Mentored Assessment.

Step 1	Register with Skate Ontario - Registration Link Pay \$30 Coach Assessor Pathway fee Skate Ontario Coach Assessor Pathway Payment Link
Step 2	Skate Ontario will assign candidates a mentor Mentor contacts candidate to conduct a Pre-brief conversation
Step 3	Candidate completes 2 hours of self or group practice i.e. watching Skills videos/webinars <i>Consider visiting Skate Canada Skating Development Video Library on YouTube</i>
Step 4	Candidate attends an Online Standards Webinar <i>These are scheduled by Skate Ontario throughout the year.</i>
Step 5	Candidate completes Co-Evaluations Candidate to complete 3 Skills Co-evaluations with 2 different Evaluators <i>Co-Evaluations do not have to be completed with your Mentor and can be completed at any Assessment Day with any Evaluator.</i> <i>Co-Evaluation Rubric to be completed by Evaluator and submitted to Skate Ontario.</i>
	Mentored Assessment <i>To be completed with your Mentor. When completed Mentored Assessment Rubric is submitted, promotion will be granted.</i>
