GENERAL INFORMATION

An invitation is extended to all eligible synchronized skating teams to participate in the 2023 Skate Ontario Synchro Series #1 – Kingston. Skate Canada rules and regulations will apply throughout the competition unless otherwise specified. Rule amendments passed at the Skate Canada Ice Summit as well as any changes to ISU regulations, applicable to Skate Canada sanctioned events shall also apply.

The 2023 Skate Ontario Synchro Series #1 – Kingston is a Provincial Championship qualifier for STAR 6 (Juvenile) and STAR 8 (Pre-Novice) and a non-qualifying (invitational) opportunity for all other synchro categories. This event is open to out of province teams.

REGISTRATION

Registration for this event is an **online submission** and must be completed in full, including payment. Registrants must also acknowledge and agree to all policies listed in the cart for the entry to be finalized.

MUSIC UPLOAD & PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT (PPC)

All program music must be submitted online through <u>Uplifter</u>. Planned Program Content must be submitted via email to <u>slafleur@skateontario.org</u>. Blank planned program sheets can be found on the Synchro Series #1 Kingston event page <u>here</u>. The deadline to submit music and PPC information is **Sunday**, **November 19**, **2023** at **11:59 PM ET**.

Music file(s) may be uploaded at the time of registration OR you may leave the music field blank to complete at a later time.

If you choose to submit your music file(s) after completing your registration, or need to update previously submitted files, log into your <u>Skate Ontario Uplifter account</u> to edit or submit the required information. Music files can be edited online up until the deadline of Sunday, November 19, 2023 at 11:59 PM. All music files must be in MP3 format.

LATE SUBMISSIONS

Each late submission of music and/or PPC after the deadline will be subject to a \$50 late fee. For example, if a team submits both their music and PPC information after the deadline, a total late fee of \$100 will be charged.

To avoid a late fee, teams must submit their music and PPC information by the deadline. Teams can make changes to their music and PPC information after the deadline by contacting the Skate Ontario Event Staff Point of Contact of the event. Please be advised that we may not be able to accommodate all changes to music and PPC information the week leading up to an event. In this case, teams may be asked to submit their music on a USB drive onsite.

Any questions about submitting music should be sent to the Skate Ontario Event Staff Point of Contact prior to the deadline.

Access to online registration will cease at 11:59 PM ET Sunday, September 17, 2023, or once registration is filled. Registrations will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Please review your entry information before submitting.

In the event that registration is filled, skaters will be able to add their names to the waitlist. If a spot becomes available, skaters will have 24 hours to register. Waitlisted skaters will be accommodated until start orders are posted.

MUSIC REQUIREMENTS

Program music must be submitted through Uplifter as an MP3 file. You may upload your music file at the time of registration, OR you may leave the music field blank, complete your registration, then log back into your account at a later date to upload your music file. If you checkout without uploading your music file, you must log into your account and upload your music file by **Sunday**, **November 19, 2023 at 11:59 PM ET.** You may also edit any uploaded music file up until this date.

BACK-UP MUSIC - USB

PLEASE NOTE: WE DO NOT HAVE THE ABILITY TO PLAY CDS

Skaters are asked to bring an MP3 back-up of their music on a USB stick to the event, to be kept ice level with their coach. For skaters competing in more than 1 category, it is HIGHLY recommended that a separate back-up USB drive be available for each piece of music.

Alternate electronic items such as cellphones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted.

PPC INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

Planned Program Content must be submitted via email to <u>slafleur@skateontario.org</u>. Blank planned program sheets can be found on the Synchro Series #1 Kingston event page <u>here</u>. The deadline to submit PPC information is **Sunday**, **November 19**, **2023 at 11:59 PM ET**.



RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration is finalized only when all information is filled in and payment completed. Your receipt of payment is your registration confirmation. Please print your receipt and retain for your records.

START ORDERS: Starting orders shall be determined by a random draw in each category.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries received after the closing date will be considered by the Technical Representative for registration. Late entries are subject to a late fee of a 50% surcharge of registration fees for all categories. No late entries will be considered after start orders are posted (two weeks before event start). All late fees are 100% non-refundable.

LATE MUSIC & PPC SUBMISSION: There will be a \$50.00 late fee applied for failing to register Music or PPC by the deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and their music and/or planned program sheet has been completed.

REFUNDS: Full refunds will be given for any cancelled categories. NO REFUNDS (including medical) will be given after registration closes.

WITHDRAWALS PRIOR TO REGISTRATION CLOSE: If an entry is withdrawn prior to the registration closing date, a refund (less an administrative fee of \$50.00 per skater/team) will be granted.

CHANGE OF CATEGORY FEE: There will be a \$50.00 change of category fee applied for each granted change request after an online registration has been submitted.

RESTRICTIONS: In the case of a very large entry in any category, the entries will be drawn into groups. All groups are final and cannot be changed.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: As of July 1, 2023.

TEST REQUIREMENTS: As of February 15, 2024.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION: All competitors and Skate Canada registered coaches are required to register upon arrival at the arena. Specific on-site registration instructions will be shared prior to the competition.

COACH ACCREDITATION: To be accredited at the 2023 Skate Ontario Synchro Series #1 - Kingston, coaches must be Regional Coach trained or certified. Up to two certified coaches will be accredited.

Ontario coaches must present their Skate Ontario issued Coach's Accreditation Tag. No other form of identification will be accepted. Out of province coaches must provide proof at that they are a Registered Skate Canada Professional Coach in Good Standing when registering at the Coaches' sign in table.

TEAM MANAGERS & CHAPERONES: All team managers and chaperones must be current registered members of Skate Canada per the Accreditation Policy.



If a team manager or chaperone is a coach, then he/she must meet all the requirements of a professional coach for the relevant event including NCCP certification level, valid First Aid certificate and coaching membership with the Association.

Two coaches, one team manager and two chaperones for a total of five people per team will be accredited. The names and Skate Canada numbers for these accreditations MUST be included on the online registration page under "Attending Personnel".

The main coach and one alternate (skater) will stand at the entrance to the ice, and the team manager and other alternates in the exit area. The chaperones will be allowed in the dressing rooms ONLY and will not have access to ice level during competition.

AWARDS: Medals for first, second and third place will be awarded for each category. Medal presentation information will be available at the competition.

PROTESTS: For events using the Cumulative Points Calculation (CPC) scoring system, protests must be made as per the <u>Skate Canada Protest Procedure</u>. Decisions of the officials categorized as field of play may not be protested, except as noted in the Protest Procedure. Items that can be protested: Participation of a competitor in the competition, Composition of panels of officials, Determination of the results of a competition

All protests regarding the determination of the result for a competitor(s) in the competition must be filed immediately after, but within no more than one hour, of the posting of the full and detailed results for the Segment in question.
