2024 Skate Ontario Qualifying Structure Provincial Championships 2023/24 Season

Athletes competing in the Skate Ontario Provincial Series in order to qualify for the 2024 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships please note the following:

- 1. The highest Provincial Series score from each athlete or team in qualifying categories will be used in the final ranking order for qualification into the 2024 Provincial Championships.
- Athletes that would like to have their scores tracked with the goal to qualify for the 2024 Skate
 Ontario Provincial Championships must declare which category(ies) they would like to qualify
 in no later than February 22nd, 2024. A declaration form will be released prior to the first event in
 the Provincial Series Calendar.
- 3. Only Skate Ontario Provincial Series scores can be used to determine a ranking position.
 - a. Consideration will be given to those athletes that receive **written permission** from the Skate Ontario Sport Department to use scores from Out-of-Province events.
- 4. Pre-Novice and Novice categories will be free program only events.
- 5. Any athlete registering for STAR 5 Gold categories in any discipline must **not have reached the age of 21 by July 1, 2023**.
- 6. Skaters who are not Canadian citizens are eligible to qualify for the 2024 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships, provided the following criteria is met:
 - a. The skater(s) is/are registered with a Skate Canada member club or skating school in Ontario.
 - b. The skater(s) is/are not representing another country at a qualifying event (e.g. Regionals/Sectionals).
 - c. The skater(s) must be released by their current Federation.
 - d. All assessment qualifications for the Skate Ontario Super Series event(s) entered are met.
- 7. Final Maximum Entry Numbers for the 2024 Provincial Championships can be found below.

Please note that Skate Ontario reserves the right to make adjustments to the number of entries based on the evolution of the 2023/24 season and in order to comply with capacity limits at the competition venue for the 2024 Provincial Championships.

8. For each category, the posted interim ranking list will only show scores for the maximum number of entries at the 2024 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships.

If you choose to submit your music after completing your registration, or need to update previously submitted files, log into your <u>Skate Ontario Uplifter account</u> to edit or submit the required information. Music files can be edited up until the deadline of **Thursday, March 7, 2024 at 11:59** PM. All music files must be in MP3 format.

REGISTRATION OPENING & CLOSING DATES

Qualified skaters and teams will be emailed a link to complete registration for the 2024 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships. Skaters/Teams are only considered registered once the registration form is complete and payment is made. An email copy of each registration invoice will be automatically generated and sent to the account holder at the email address on the registrant's profile.

Failure to register by the deadline indicates that the skater/team has chosen not to participate, and the spot will go to the next highest ranked skater/team. No late entries will be accepted. Skaters/Teams are only considered as being registered once the registration form is complete and payment is made.

Synchro Categories

Registration for Synchro categories will open at 12:00 PM (noon) EST on Friday, February 16, 2024, and will close at 11:59 pm EST on Thursday, February 22, 2024.

Singles, Pair, Ice Dance & Artistic Categories

Registration for Singles, Pair, Artistic, and Ice Dance categories will open at 12:00 PM EST on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, and close at 11:59 EST pm on Thursday, March 7, 2024.

MUSIC REQUIREMENTS

Program music must be submitted through Uplifter as an MP3 file. This includes all Series 8 pattern dance music. You may upload your music file at the time of registration, OR you may leave the music field blank, complete your registration, then log back into your account at a later date to upload your music file. If you checkout without uploading your music file, you must log into your account and upload your music file by the deadline stated above for your category. You may also edit any uploaded music file up until this date.

BACK-UP MUSIC - USB:

PLEASE NOTE: WE DO NOT HAVE THE ABILITY TO PLAY CDS

Skaters are asked to bring a MP3 version back-up of their music on a USB stick to the event, to be kept ice level with their coach. For skaters competing in more than 1 category, it is HIGHLY recommended that a separate back-up USB drive be available for each piece of music.

Alternate electronic items such as cellphones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration is finalized only when all information is filled in and payment completed. Your receipt of payment is your registration confirmation. Please print your receipt and retain for your records.

START ORDERS: Start Orders shall be determined by a random draw for the first segment. For categories with 2 segments, competitors will be assigned to skate the second segment in reverse order of the results from the first segment.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries received after the closing date will be considered by the Technical Representative for registration. Late entries are subject to a \$50.00 late fee. No late entries will be considered after start orders are posted (two weeks before event start). All late fees are 100% non-refundable.

LATE MUSIC & PPC SUBMISSION: There will be a \$50.00 late fee applied for failing to register Music and/or PPC online by the deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and their music has been submitted.

REFUNDS: Full refunds will be given for any cancelled categories. NO REFUNDS (including medical) will be given after registration closes.

WITHDRAWALS PRIOR TO REGISTRATION CLOSE: If an entry is withdrawn prior to the registration closing date, a refund (less an administrative fee of \$50.00 per skater/team) will be granted.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: As of July 1, 2023.

MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS: All categories have a maximum age limit of 21 as of July 1, 2023.



TEST REQUIREMENTS: As of February 15, 2024.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION: All competitors and Skate Canada registered coaches are required to register upon arrival at the arena. Specific on-site registration instructions will be shared prior to the competition.

COACH ACCREDITATION: To be accredited at any 2023/2024 Skate Ontario Provincial Series event, coaches must be Regional Coach trained or certified. Up to two certified coaches per entry will be accredited.

Ontario coaches must present their Skate Ontario issued Coach's Accreditation Tag. No other form of identification will be accepted. Out of province coaches must provide proof at that they are a Registered Skate Canada Professional Coach in Good Standing when registering at the Coaches' sign in table.

AWARDS: Medals for first, second and third place will be awarded for each category, with the exception to Accessed to Standard categories. Medal presentation information will be available at the competition.

PROTESTS: For events using the Cumulative Points Calculation (CPC) scoring system, protests must be made as per the <u>Skate Canada Protest Procedure</u>. Decisions of the officials categorized as field of play may not be protested, except as noted in the Protest Procedure. Items that can be protested: Participation of a competitor in the competition, Composition of panels of officials, Determination of the results of a competition

All protests regarding the determination of the result for a competitor(s) in the competition must be filed immediately after, but within no more than one hour, of the posting of the full and detailed results for the Segment in question.
