## COACHES' CONFIRMATION EMAILS

Coaches will receive an email confirming their athlete's registration information (if the correct email is provided at registration). It is the responsibility of the registrant to ensure the accuracy of the coach(es) email.

## REGISTRATION

Registration for this event is an **online submission** and must be completed in full, including payment. Registrants must also acknowledge and agree to all policies listed in the cart for the entry to be finalized.

### **MUSIC UPLOAD**

Music information will be submitted through [Uplifter](#). Deadline to submit music is **Sunday, October 29, 2023 at 11:59 PM**.

Music file(s) may be uploaded at the time of registration OR you may leave the music field blank and complete at a later time.

If you choose to submit your music after completing your registration or need to update previously submitted files, log into your [Skate Ontario Uplifter account](#) to edit or submit the required information. Music can be edited up until the deadline of Sunday, October 29, 2023 at 11:59 PM. All music files must be in MP3 format.

### **LATE SUBMISSIONS**

All late submissions of music after the deadline will be subjected to a \$50 late fee each.

To avoid a late fee, skaters must submit their music by the deadline. Skaters can still make updates after the closing date by contacting the Skate Ontario Event Staff Point of Contact for the event. Be advised that changes made in the week leading to the event may not be able to be accommodated and a USB back-up for music may have to be used on-site.

Any questions about submitting music should be sent to the Skate Ontario Event Staff Point of Contact prior to the deadline.

## REGISTRATION OPENING & CLOSING DATES

### **ASSIGNED ATHLETE REGISTRATION**

Registration for this event opens to all skaters who receive confirmation of advanced registration and the registration link at 12:00 pm EST on September 18, 2023 and closes at 11:59 pm EST on September 20, 2023.

## PUBLIC REGISTRATION

Registration for this event opens to the public at 12:00 PM EST on September 22, 2023, and will close at 11:59 PM EST on September 25, 2023.

## CATEGORIES

Starting Orders shall be determined by a random draw for the first segment. For categories with 2 segments, competitors will be assigned to skate the second segment in reverse order of the results from the first segment.

## MUSIC REQUIREMENTS

Program music must be submitted through Uplifter as an MP3 file. This includes all Series 8 pattern dance music. You may upload your music file at the time of registration, OR you may leave the music field blank, complete your registration, then log back into your account at a later date to upload your music file. If you checkout without uploading your music file, you must log into your account and upload your music file by Sunday, October 29, 2023 at 11:59 PM. You may also edit any uploaded music file up until this date.

### **BACK-UP MUSIC - USB:**

#### **PLEASE NOTE: WE DO NOT HAVE THE ABILITY TO PLAY CDS**

Skaters are asked to bring a MP3 version back-up of their music on a USB stick to the event, to be kept ice level with their coach. For skaters competing in more than 1 category, it is HIGHLY recommended that a separate back-up USB drive be available for each piece of music.

Alternate electronic items such as cellphones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted.

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration is finalized only when all information is filled in and payment completed. Your receipt of payment is your registration confirmation. Please print your receipt and retain for your records.

**STARTING ORDERS:** Starting Orders shall be determined by a random draw for the first segment. For categories with 2 segments, competitors will be assigned to skate the second segment in reverse order of the results from the first segment.

**LATE ENTRIES:** Entries received after the closing date will be considered by the Technical Representative for registration. Late entries are subject to a \$50.00 late fee. No late entries will be considered after start orders are posted (two weeks before event start). All late fees are 100% non-refundable.

**LATE MUSIC SUBMISSION:** There will be a \$50.00 late fee applied for failing to register Music online by the deadline. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and their music has been submitted.

**REFUNDS:** Full refunds will be given for any cancelled categories. NO REFUNDS (including medical) will be given after registration closes.

**WITHDRAWALS PRIOR TO REGISTRATION CLOSE:** If an entry is withdrawn prior to the registration closing date, a refund (less an administrative fee of \$50.00 per skater/team) will be granted.

**CHANGE OF CATEGORY FEE:** There will be a \$50.00 change of category fee applied for each granted change request after an online registration has been submitted.

## RESTRICTIONS:

- In the case of a very large entry in any category, the entries will be drawn into groups. All groups are final and cannot be changed.
- Single skaters are permitted to enter only one singles freeskate category. For example: registering for STAR 6 Freeskate and Juvenile Freeskate are not permitted. Athletes may register for one freeskate category and one short program category (STAR 7 or STAR 9). Athletes may register for two different disciplines such as a singles category and a dance category.

**AGE REQUIREMENTS:** As of July 1, 2023.

**MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS:** All categories have a maximum age limit of 21 as of July 1, 2023.

**TEST REQUIREMENTS:** As of February 15, 2024.

**ON-SITE REGISTRATION:** All competitors and Skate Canada registered coaches are required to register upon arrival at the arena. Specific on-site registration instructions will be shared prior to the competition.



**COACH ACCREDITATION:** To be accredited at any 2023/2024 Skate Ontario Provincial Series event, coaches must be Regional Coach trained or certified. Up to two certified coaches per entry will be accredited.

Ontario coaches must present their Skate Ontario issued Coach's Accreditation Tag. No other form of identification will be accepted. Out of province coaches must provide proof that they are a Registered Skate Canada Professional Coach in Good Standing when registering at the Coaches' sign in table.

**AWARDS:** Medals for first, second and third place will be awarded for each category, with the exception to Assessed to Standard categories. Medal presentation information will be available at the competition.

**RIBBON CATEGORIES:** For all categories Assessed to Standard, including all STAR 1-3 categories, recipients will be called to the presentation area by their skating order and presented their ribbon and report card

**PROTESTS:** For events using the Cumulative Points Calculation (CPC) scoring system, protests must be made as per the [Skate Canada Protest Procedure](#). Decisions of the officials categorized as field of play may not be protested, except as noted in the Protest Procedure. Items that can be protested: Participation of a competitor in the competition, Composition of panels of officials, Determination of the results of a competition

All protests regarding the determination of the result for a competitor(s) in the competition must be filed immediately after, but within no more than one hour, of the posting of the full and detailed results for the Segment in question.
