Entry Pre-Requisites

- Be Regional Coach certified.
- Be a current registered Skate Canada Coach in good standing.
- Has completed the following Skate Canada eLearning training:
 - Complete Pre-Course eLearning modules (minimum of three and one must be the PC Cross-Discipline eLearning module) in the disciplines of your choice.

Provincial Coach In-Training Status

Attend discipline specific virtual courses (minimum of two) that match the pre-course modules:

- Singles
- Pairs (pre-requisite is singles pre-course and virtual course)
- Ice Dance
- Synchro
- Attend the 1-day Cross Discipline Foundational Training in-person course.



Provincial Coach Trained Status

Complete the following NCCP multi-sport training offered by a [PTCR](#).

- Performance Planning

If not previously done, complete the following additional multi-sport training:

- Make Ethical Decisions
- Teaching & Learning
- Plan a Practice
