2025 Skate Ontario Qualifying Structure Provincial Championships 2024/2025 Season

Athletes competing in the Skate Ontario Provincial Series in order to qualify for the 2025 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships please note the following:

1. The highest Provincial Series score from each athlete or team in qualifying categories will be used in the final ranking order for qualification into the 2025 Provincial Championships.
2. Athletes that would like to have their scores tracked with the goal to qualify for the 2025 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships must declare which category(ies) they would like to qualify in no later than February 10th, 2025. A declaration form will be released prior to the first event in the Provincial Series Calendar.
3. Only Skate Ontario Provincial Series scores can be used to determine a ranking position.
 - a. Consideration will be given to those athletes that receive written permission from the Skate Ontario Sport Department to use scores from Out-of-Province events.
4. Pre-Novice and Novice categories will be free program only events.
5. Any athlete registering for STAR 5 – Gold categories in any discipline must not have reached the age of 21 by July 1, 2024.
6. For any athlete competing in a category that is divided by age, athletes are required to compete in the appropriate age bracket. ex. If an athlete is competing in Pre-Juvenile and is 10 years old as of July 1 of that year, they are not eligible to compete in Pre-Juvenile U13.
7. Skaters who are not Canadian citizens are eligible to qualify for the 2025 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships, provided the following criteria is met:
 - a. The athlete(s) is/are registered with a Skate Canada member club or skating school in Ontario.
 - b. The athlete(s) is/are not representing another country at a qualifying event (e.g. Regionals/Sectionals).
 - c. The athlete(s) must be released by their current Federation.
 - d. All assessment qualifications for the Skate Ontario Super Series event(s) entered are met.
8. Final Maximum Entry Numbers for the 2025 Provincial Championships can be found below.

Please note that Skate Ontario reserves the right to make adjustments to the number of entries based on the evolution of the 2024/2025 season and in order to comply with capacity limits at the competition venue for the 2025 Provincial Championships.

9. For each category, the posted interim ranking list will only show scores for the maximum number of entries at the 2025 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships.
 - a. In the event that two athletes or teams receive the same score and are tied within the rankings, athletes or teams will be listed in the rankings based on the following:
 1. In a Short Program or Pattern Dance – the athlete or team with the higher Total Element score will be ranked higher.
 2. In a Free Program or Free Dance – the athlete or team with the higher Program Component score will be ranked higher.

REGISTRATION

Registration for this event is an **online submission** and must be completed in full, including payment. Registrants must also acknowledge and agree to all policies listed in the cart for the entry to be finalized.

REGISTRATION OPENING & CLOSING DATES

Qualified skaters and teams will be emailed a link to complete registration for the 2025 Skate Ontario Provincial Championships. The link to the registration portal will be emailed within 24 hours of registration opening. **Please check your junk mail for an email from Katherine Short.** If you cannot locate your registration link, please contact Katherine Short at kshort@skateontario.org.

Skaters/Teams are only considered registered once the registration form is complete and payment is made. An email copy of each registration invoice will be automatically generated and sent to the account holder at the email address on the registrant's profile.

Failure to register by the deadline indicates that the skater/team has chosen not to participate, and the spot will go to the next highest ranked skater/team. No late entries will be accepted. Skaters/Teams are only considered as being registered once the registration form is complete and payment is made.

Synchro Categories

Registration for Synchro categories will open at 12:00 PM (noon) EST on Monday, February 17, 2025, and will close at 11:59 pm EST on Sunday, February 23rd, 2025.

Singles, Pair, Ice Dance & Artistic Categories

Registration for Singles, Pair, Artistic, and Ice Dance categories will open at 12:00 PM EST on Monday, March 3rd, 2025, and close at 11:59 EST pm on Wednesday, March 5, 2025.

Please note: The registration period for these categories is less than 72 hours.

Start Orders shall be determined by a random draw for the first segment. For categories with 2 segments, competitors will be assigned to skate the second segment in reverse order of the results from the first segment.

MUSIC REQUIREMENTS

Program music must be submitted through SkateReg as an MP3 file **at the time of registration**.

Music not submitted by the deadline of 11:59 PM EST Sunday, February 23rd, 2025 (Synchro) and 11:59 PM EST Wednesday, March 5th (All other categories) will be subject to a \$50.00 late submission fee. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and their music has been submitted.

PPC INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

Planned Program Content (PPC) collection will be through SkateReg **at the time of registration.**

PPCs not submitted by the deadline of 11:59 PM EST Sunday, February 23rd, 2025 (Synchro) and 11:59 PM EST Wednesday, March 5th (All other categories) will be subject to a \$50.00 late submission fee. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and their PPCs have been submitted.

CONFIRMATION EMAILS

A summary of the registration will be automatically generated and sent to the email address on the registrant's profile. Registration receipts can be found on your SkateReg account.

Coaches will not receive an email confirmation of their skater's registration. The SkateReg Coach Dashboard is still in development and therefore coaches will not be able to see which categories their skater(s) have registered in at this time. Skaters should confirm with their coaches that they have registered.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration is finalized only when all information is filled in and payment completed. Your receipt of payment is your registration confirmation. Please print your receipt and retain for your records.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: As of July 1, 2024.

MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS: All STAR categories have a maximum age limit of 21 as of July 1, 2024.

TEST REQUIREMENTS: As of February 15, 2025.

START ORDERS/RESULTS/DETAIL SHEETS: The start order/results and detail sheets will be posted on the [Skate Ontario website](#). Results and detail sheets will NOT be provided on-site at the competition.

REFUNDS: Full refunds will be given for any cancelled categories. NO REFUNDS (including medical) will be given after registration closes.

WITHDRAWALS PRIOR TO REGISTRATION CLOSE: If an entry is withdrawn prior to the registration closing date, a refund (less an administrative fee of \$50.00 per skater/team) will be granted.

LATE MUSIC & PPC SUBMISSION: There will be a \$50.00 late fee applied for failing to register Music by the deadline listed in the announcement. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and their music has been submitted.

WITHDRAW PROCEDURE: Skaters needing to withdraw from the event, should email the Skate Ontario Event Staff Point of Contact (SOSPOC). Written notice should come directly from the skater, parent/guardian, or either of the listed attending coaches.

WAIVERS: All waivers must be signed and completed through SkateReg, Skate Ontario's event registration system, prior to on-site registration.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION: All competitors and Skate Canada registered coaches are required to register upon arrival at the arena. Specific on-site registration instructions will be shared prior to the competition.

COACH ACCREDITATION: To be accredited at the 2024/2025 Skate Ontario Provincial Series event, coaches must be Regional Coach trained or certified and in Good Standing with Skate Canada. Up to two certified coaches per entry will be accredited.

Ontario coaches must present their Skate Ontario issued Coach's Accreditation Tag. No other form of identification will be accepted. Out of province coaches must provide proof at that they are a Registered Skate Canada Professional Coach in Good Standing when registering at the Coaches' sign in table. These coaches may be asked to show their Skate Canada dashboard.

AWARDS: Medals for first, second and third place will be awarded for each category. Medal presentation information will be available at the competition.

PROTESTS: For events using the Cumulative Points Calculation (CPC) scoring system, protests must be made as per the [Skate Canada Protest Procedure](#). Decisions of the officials categorized as field of play may not be protested, except as noted in the Protest Procedure. Items that can be protested: Participation of a competitor in the competition, Composition of panels of officials, Determination of the results of a competition

All protests regarding the determination of the result for a competitor(s) in the competition must be filed immediately after, but within no more than one hour, of the posting of the full and detailed results for the Segment in question. Must be in writing.
