An invitation is extended to all eligible figure skaters to participate in 2024/2025 Skate Ontario Provincial Series #14 - Skate Lakeshore. Skate Canada rules and regulations will apply throughout the competition unless otherwise specified. Rule amendments passed at the Skate Canada Ice Summit as well as any changes to ISU regulations, applicable to Skate Canada sanctioned events shall also apply.

Provincial Series #14 – Skate Lakeshore will be officiated remotely in real time by Skate Ontario officials. Results will be made available immediately after being approved by the Referee & Technical Controller. There will be an on-site Tech Ref, Ice Level Referee, and Skate Ontario Representative throughout the event.

REMOTE OFFICIATING

Provincial Series #14 – Skate Lakeshore will be **officiated remotely** in real time by Skate Ontario officials.

This event will have skaters on site at the event venue with officials off-site scoring virtually in real-time from their home. A live feed will be made available to assigned officials for Technical Panel review and judging. Officials use the same scoring interface as per regular competitions.

Remote Scoring connects officials electronically to enable them to perform most of the duties they would at an in-person event. Each panel of officials is connected to each other throughout the entire event by video conferencing.

On-site there will be the Tech Rep and an Ice Level Referee. As well as, a Skate Ontario Representative to answer any questions and address any concerns.

Be prepared that the officiating time may take longer from what you are use to at events where the officials are on-site. Additional time is built into the schedule to allow for this.

Results will be posted on the Skate Ontario website immediately after being reviewed, signed, and approved by the Referee and Technical Controller. As the Referee and Technical Controller are not physically on-site, there may be time delays with the final results being posted online. Please be aware that official, final results may take upwards to 1 hour after the completion of the group.

Once results are posted online, on-site Award Presentations will take place. As noted, it may take upwards to an hour for results to be published. Additional details about Award Presentations will be made available closer to the event.

REGISTRATION

Registration for this event is an **online submission** and must be completed in full, including payment. Registrants must also acknowledge and agree to all policies listed in the cart for the entry to be finalized.

Registration for this event opens to all skaters who receive confirmation of advanced registration and the registration link at 12:00 pm EST on November 29, 2024 and closes at 11:59 pm EST on December 2, 2024.

PUBLIC REGISTRATION

Registration for this event opens to the public at 12:00 PM EST on December 4, 2024, and will close at 11:59 PM EST on December 8, 2024.

MUSIC REQUIREMENTS

Program music must be submitted through SkateReg as an MP3 file. You may upload your music file at the time of registration, OR leave the music field blank, complete your registration, and then log back into your account at a later date to upload your music file.

If you checkout without uploading your music file, you must log into your account and upload your music file by **Wednesday**, **January 22**nd, **2025 at 11:59 PM**. You may also edit any uploaded music file up until this date.



Music not submitted by the deadline of Wednesday, January 22nd at 11:59 PM will be subjected to a \$50.00 late fee. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and their music has been submitted.

BACK-UP MUSIC - USB:

Skaters are asked to bring a MP3 version back-up of their music on a USB stick to the event, to be kept ice level with their coach. For skaters competing in more than 1 category, it is HIGHLY recommended that a separate back-up USB drive be available for each piece of music.

Alternate electronic items such as cellphones, tablets, mp3 players etc. will not be accepted.

PPC INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

Planned Program Content (PPC) collection will be through SkateReg. You may upload your PPCs at the time of registration, OR leave the PPC fields blank, complete your registration, and then log back into your account at a later date to complete your PPC submission.

PPCs not submitted by the deadline of Wednesday, January 22nd, 2024 at 11:59 PM will be subjected to a \$50.00 late fee. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and their PPCs have been submitted.

AWARDS

Results will be posted on the Skate Ontario website immediately after being reviewed, signed, and approved by the Referee and Technical Controller. As the Referee and Technical Controller are not physically on-site, there may be time delays with the final results being posted online. CONFIRMATION EMAILS



A summary of the registration will be automatically generated and sent to the email address on the registrant's profile. Registration receipts can be found on your SkateReg account.

Coaches will not receive an email confirmation of their skater's registration. The SkateReg Coach Dashboard is still in development and therefore coaches will not be able to see which categories their skater(s) have registered in at this time. Skaters should confirm with their coaches that they have registered.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Registration is finalized only when all information is filled in and payment completed. Your receipt of payment is your registration confirmation. Please print your receipt and retain for your records.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: As of July 1, 2024.

MAXIMUM AGE REQUIREMENTS: All STAR categories have a maximum age limit of 21 as of July 1, 2024.

AGE CATEGORIES: For any skater competing in a category that is divided by age, skaters are required to compete in the appropriate age bracket. Example: If an skater is competing in Pre-Juvenile and is 10 years old as of July 1 of that year, they are not eligible to compete in Pre-Juvenile U13.

TEST REQUIREMENTS: As of February 15, 2025.

REGISTERED IN MULTIPLE CATEGORIES: Skaters choosing to enter multiple categories, do so with the understanding that there may be scheduling conflicts that allow for minimum preparation time between categories.

STARTING ORDERS: Starting Orders shall be determined by a random draw for the first segment. For categories with 2 segments, competitors will be assigned to skate the second segment in reverse order of the results from the first segment.

START ORDERS/RESULTS/DETAIL SHEETS: The start order/results and detail sheets will be posted on the <u>Skate Ontario website</u>. Results and detail sheets will NOT be provided on-site at the competition.

LATE ENTRIES: Entries received after the closing date will be considered by the Technical Representative for registration. Late entries are subject to a late fee of a \$50.00. No late entries will be considered after start orders are posted (two weeks before event start). All late fees are 100% non-refundable.

SINGLE ENTRIES: Skate Ontario reserves the right to cancel any categories with only 1 registrant. If an event has only one registrant, they will be contacted about next steps after registration closes.

CANCELLED CATEGORIES: Skate Ontario reserves the right to cancel any categories based on registration needs.



REFUNDS: Full refunds will be given for any cancelled categories. NO REFUNDS (including medical) will be given after registration closes.

WITHDRAWALS PRIOR TO REGISTRATION CLOSE: If an entry is withdrawn prior to the registration closing date, a refund (less an administrative fee of \$50.00 per skater/team) will be granted.

CHANGE OF CATEGORY FEE: There will be a \$50.00 change of category fee applied for each granted change request after an online registration has been submitted.

LATE MUSIC SUBMISSION: There will be a \$50.00 late fee applied for failing to register Music by the deadline listed in the announcement. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and their music has been submitted.

PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT (PPC): There will be a \$50.00 late fee applied for failing to submit PPCs by the deadline listed in the announcement. Skaters will not be permitted to register at the competition until this fee has been paid and their PPCs have been submitted.

RESTRICTIONS:

- In the case of a very large entry in any category, the entries will be drawn into groups which will be determined by random draw. All groups are final and cannot be changed.
- Single skaters are permitted to enter only one singles freeskate category. For example: registering for STAR 6 Freeskate and Juvenile Freeskate are not permitted. Skaters may register for one freeskate category and one short program category. Skaters may register for two different disciplines such as a singles category and a dance category.

WITHDRAW PROCEDURE: Skaters needing to withdraw from the event, should email the Skate Ontario Event Staff Point of Contact (SOSPOC). Written notice should come directly from the skater, parent/guardian, or either of the listed attending coaches.

WAIVERS: All waivers must be signed and completed through SkateReg, Skate Ontario's event registration system, prior to on-site registration.

ON-SITE REGISTRATION: All competitors and Skate Canada registered coaches are required to register upon arrival at the arena. Specific on-site registration instructions will be shared prior to the competition.

COACH ACCREDITATION: To be accredited at the 2024/2025 Skate Ontario Provincial Series event, coaches must be Regional Coach trained or certified and in Good Standing with Skate Canada. Up to two certified coaches per entry will be accredited.

Ontario coaches must present their Skate Ontario issued Coach's Accreditation Tag. No other form of identification will be accepted. Out of province coaches must provide proof at that they are a Registered Skate Canada Professional Coach in Good Standing when registering at the Coaches' sign in table. These coaches may be asked to show their Skate Canada dashboard.



AWARDS: Medals for first, second and third place will be awarded for each category. Medal presentation information will be available at the competition.

PROTESTS: For events using the Cumulative Points Calculation (CPC) scoring system, protests must be made as per the <u>Skate Canada Protest Procedure</u>. Decisions of the officials categorized as field of play may not be protested, except as noted in the Protest Procedure. Items that can be protested: Participation of a competitor in the competition, Composition of panels of officials, Determination of the results of a competition

All protests regarding the determination of the result for a competitor(s) in the competition must be filed immediately after, but within no more than one hour, of the posting of the full and detailed results for the Segment in question. Must be in writing.
