Ontario Skaters' Promotional Contest

Introduction

Welcome to the 38th year for the Ontario Skaters Promotional Contest. This program is a wonderful opportunity for skaters and clubs/skating schools, throughout the province of Ontario, to fund-raise and create public awareness of the sport of figure skating within your community. Assistance to your club/skating school will be provided through detailed information in this booklet and by contacting the Skate Ontario representative responsible for this year's contest, Michelle Timmins (contact details listed below).

This is an Ontario-wide program. Skate Ontario will cover the up-front costs required to produce this year's Promotional Contest program, prizes, and promotion materials. You remit for the tickets after the fundraising has been collected. For many clubs/skating schools, the funds raised from the Ontario Skaters Promotional Contest are invaluable. Donated funds assist your skaters and members in many ways and most directly assist to off-set ice costs and fees to participate in the sport.

General Information

What is it:

A promotional contest with tickets distributed in Ontario. There are 20 tickets per book. The suggested donation is \$2.00 per ticket. Estimated value of the book is \$40.00.

1. Club Share = \$22.00
2. Skate Ontario = \$18.00

Contest Period:

To enable you to reach all your membership the contest period begins September 2, 2026, and will run through May 7, 2027, with the prize draw happening on Friday June 4, 2027, at 12 noon EST.

All sold ticket stubs, unsold booklets, a cheque for amount owed, and the remittance form must be **returned to Skate Ontario no later than Friday May 21, 2027**, to provide sufficient lead time for the accounting process and to ensure that ticket stubs are submitted into the draw by Friday June 4, 2027.

How does it work:

1. Club/skating school completes the order form in the link below by Friday March 12, 2027. Club/skating school commits to a number of books to distribute and is responsible for those books.
2. The club/skating school then distributes the booklets to their members to sell. Skaters/parents are responsible to return their ticket stubs to the club/skating school's fundraising contact before the end of the contest period and the club/skating school will submit all ticket stubs, remittance form and payment for the sold booklets to Skate Ontario. Unsold full booklets can be returned free of charge. When ordering your contest books, only order what is manageable for your club/skating school to sell. Should your club/skating school require more booklets, subsequent orders may be submitted (providing there are booklets left to fulfill the order).
3. The club/skating school establishes a date for all ticket stubs and unsold booklets to be returned. The club/skating school will complete the online remittance form (link below) and will submit all detached ticket stubs and payment for the sold booklets along with all unsold booklets to Skate Ontario. Cheques are made payable to Skate Ontario for \$18.00/sold or partially sold booklet. Payment must accompany ticket stubs. Unsold booklets must be returned, or the club/skating school will be responsible for remitting \$18.00/booklet to Skate Ontario.

*If one (1) ticket is sold out of a booklet the club must remit payment of \$18.00/book to Skate Ontario, so ensure that you sell all the tickets from one booklet before starting to sell tickets from another book.

Important Note:

When returning your ticket stubs to Skate Ontario, please tear all ticket stubs from the booklets and have them ready to be added into the draw upon receipt at Skate Ontario.

Step 1: Tear this portion of the ticket from the booklet and give it to the person who purchased it.



Step 2: Tear the ticket(s) from the booklet along the perforated line, and return this portion of the ticket(s) to Skate Ontario.
